- Students in middle school and high school must independently create their designs.
- Students may not copy a design from somewhere else. It must be student's own creation.
- Students in first through fifth grade may have adult help with purchasing, cutting, or any other tricky parts, but the design must be created by the child.
- Only student capes will be judged. For example, it's ok to wear your tall boots and a mask, but know that only the cape you created will be judged.
